Woodies Youth Centre

We are fortunate to have on school site a Youth Club, run by Medway Council by experienced and qualified youth workers.

Woodies is open on **Monday evenings 7.0pm-9pm** for fun, games and the chance to do some AQA qualifications

AQA qualifications in Hair & Beauty, Community Skills & Citizenship, Cooking, Sport, Personal & Social Education, Art, Music and Dance are available. For just **£15 per year**, you can take as many or few qualifications as you wish. 50p entry on the door and you will get something to add to your CV as well as gaining qualifications and some hands-on skills which will help later in life!

On **Tuesday and Thursday evenings (6.30-8.30pm)**, the MAGIC Youth Group meets to support young people (aged 8-13 and 14-19) with Autism and Aspergers.

Social Evenings happen on **Wednesday and Friday evenings** from **6.45pm-9.0pm**, where a range of activities happen. If you are **aged 8-18**, you are welcome to attend! There are also opportunities to get out and about—speak to a youth worker about these extra activities! 50p on the door.

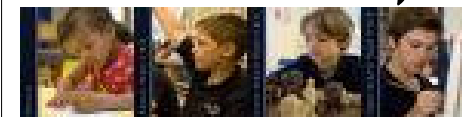
