

## The Thomas Aveling School Behaviour for Success

As students of Thomas Aveling we will work very hard to make behaviour in our school outstanding by following the recipe of success below. The school council is the route to bring up any issues that you would like discussed.

I. All Thomas Aveling students should move through the school in an orderly manner.

- a. Everyone in the school should walk on the left side of corridors, in single file if necessary.
- b. We should follow the no entry and single direction signs and avoid office and meeting rooms in A block.
- c. We should not run within the school building or in the courtyard areas.

3. All Thomas Aveling students should present themselves in the correct uniform at all times.

- a. We will wear the correct school uniform.
- b. We should follow instructions of members of staff immediately and without argument about incorrect uniform.

- a. We should challenge others who drop litter throughout school and in <u>our</u> local community.
- b. We will never participate in any form of anti-social behaviour.
- c. We will not intimidate other students through our direct or indirect actions.
- d. We will be proactive about making our school a non-smoking site and stand up for our rights by reporting anyone smoking or out of bounds to school staff.
- e. We will follow the 'hands-off' policy at all times.
- f. We will not swarm towards fights or arguments but will instead let a member of staff know.

5. All Thomas Aveling students should show a readiness for learning at all times.

- a. We will line up outside of our classrooms in single file when waiting to enter to avoid corridor congestion.
- b. We will be punctual to lessons and ready to start learning straight away.
- c. We will have planners, books, homework and equipment on the table ready for learning.
- d. We will not disrupt learning in any way.
- e. We will not use mobile phones in lessons unless asked to.
