Introducing Insight Mobile App

At Thomas Aveling, we view the home school links as extremely valuable, and we are always looking to improve the quality and accessibility of communication further. We are therefore very pleased to be introducing the Insight App to Thomas Aveling School. This is the SIMs parent portal engagement app which will in time allow you to:

- Check the details we hold for you are correct, and if not request an update
- View am/pm and lesson attendance data and timetable information
- View merits and rewards and behaviour logs
- View latest Grade-sheets and all your child's progress grades

The key advantages of the App are a one-time log in, and the ability to launch the App from your phone or tablet on the go. There are separate student and parent editions. We hope to increase usage and engagement of SIMs Insight which can provide parents with some really useful up to date information.

You log-in details for the mobile App will be exactly the same as those you currently use for accessing the web based version of Insight. If you need any assistance please contact mbaker@thomasaveling.co.uk. If you do not have access to a smart phone or tablet you can continue to log in and use Insight on the web in the usual way. To download the App:

1. Search for Insight in your app-store (Apple Store or Google Play)
2. Download the App – Insight by TASC Software Solutions Ltd
3. Scan the QR code when asked to connect your App to the Thomas Aveling School or enter the web address <https://insight.thomasaveling.co.uk/INSIGHT/>
4. Sign in with your normal login details
